Easy Monthly Maintenance Checklist for Landscapes

MONTHLY TASKS

- Mow your lawn and keep grass height between 3 to 4 inches
- Edge along driveways, sidewalks, and flower beds
- Pick up leaves, branches, and trash from the yard
- Check sprinklers and make sure they are working properly
- Pull out big weeds before they spread
- Water deeply but less often (best done early morning)
- Trim bushes and plants that are growing out of shape
- Check for dry, brown, or dead spots in the grass
- Clean up around fences and gates
- Make sure water is not collecting or pooling anywhere

Seasonal Reminders

- **Spring:** Heavy cleanup, apply spring fertilizer, plant new flowers
- **Summer:** Increase watering during extreme heat, watch for pests
- **Fall:** Remove heavy leaves, prepare plants for winter
- **Winter:** Protect sensitive plants, clear snow from walkways

Pro Tips for Lubbock Yards

- Never mow wet grass
- Water less frequently but for longer time (deep watering)
- Clay soil holds water, avoid overwatering
- Strong winds dry soil quickly, mulch is very important
- Check your yard after every strong wind storm

For Busy Homeowners

This checklist is made for normal working people with families. You don't need to do everything in one day. Try to complete 4 to 5 tasks every weekend. Small consistent effort keeps your yard looking great.
